SUBJECT: **EXPRESSION OF INTEREST**
Patrol Members (for Kangaroo Island Surf Music Festival, November 2011)

Surfing SA has requested volunteers from Surf Life Saving SA (SLSSA) to assist with patrols for the upcoming Kangaroo Island (KI) Surf Music Festival to be held at Vivonne Bay, KI.

SLSSA is seeking current financial members who hold a proficient Bronze Medallion (competence patrolling in 'surf/wave' conditions is preferred) to assist with water cover/patrol on all or any (preferably at least two [2]) of the following dates:

- Thursday 3 November
- Friday 4 November
- Saturday 5 November**
- Sunday 6 November**

Patrol hours on these days will commence at approximately 11.00am, and conclude at approximately 5.00pm. These hours may be less depending on the availability of volunteers.

**Please note the 5th and 6th November is the official start of the patrol season for the state.

If you are able to provide some assistance, whether you can patrol all four (4) days, or only two (2), please fill in the expression of interest form on the following page.

SLSSA will provide and coordinate the patrol equipment needed on the island; those available to assist with patrols are asked to bring their own swim/body boarding fins for use on patrol.

Travel/accommodation and other arrangements (the following arrangements are still being negotiated with Surfing SA who will offer as much support as possible to our volunteers), this support will include:

- **Transport** from Cape Jervis (via ferry) to the Island (venue) and back will be provided, volunteers are asked to make their own way to and from Cape Jervis.
- **Accommodation** (tents) will be provided, with volunteers housed at the Sealink site free of charge. Those who would prefer to camp (using their own tents) at the festival site are welcome to do so, provided they commit to their nominated patrols.
- **Meals** (breakfast, lunch and dinner) will be provided for volunteers.
- **Other inclusions with arrangement:**
 - Free ticket to the music festival



Please note: Other emergency service organisations such as SES, St Johns and SA Ambulance Service will also be providing assistance at the event.

SLSSA is also liaising with the RWC Service regarding water support for the event.
