Subject: Carnival Officials - Club Quota

The table below provides the number of officials required by each club to enable a carnival to be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations as set out by SLSA.

- Clubs are required to provide officials at all carnivals whether they have competitors competing or not.
- Referees will close down areas or remove a club from the competition arena should a club fail to meet their obligation.
- The Board of Surf Sports is currently considering a range of other penalties that will be imposed on clubs failing to fulfil their quota. These will be communicated in the normal manner once finalised.
- Club obligations are to be met for the duration of the carnival (Start to Finish).

As we are all aware, if we are unable to meet the prescribed quota we will be unable to provide the competition required by clubs and competitors. We seek your support to avoid disappointment. Officials are to report to Chief Marshall to “Sign On” at the Start of the day and “Sign Off” at the end of the day.
