Please note the following information regarding the conduct of the South Port component of the 2010 Senior State Championships:

Tractors will operate from 6.00 am on both days. Clubs requiring boats for Lifesaver Relay will be given priority followed by Surf Boat Relay competitors. All of these boats are required early. Others can follow once all Lifesaver and Surf Boat Relay boats are in position.

Portable Toilets will be available on the beach.

Note marshalling times including:

Saturday:

- Lifesaver Relay Marshal at 7.00 am and other events Marshal at 8.00 am

Sunday:

- 2 km run Marshal at 7.30 am for 8.00 am start
- Surf Boat Registration - 8.00 am
- 6 Person R&R – Final – Marshal 8.00 am to commence at 8.30 am
- Under 17, Under 23 and Open March Past to Marshal at 12.00 pm to commence at 12.30 pm

Clubs are required to meet officials quota but also please encourage all available officials to attend. This would be greatly appreciated.

Protests -\$100 required per protest up front, there will be no invoices. A reminder that a verbal protest within 5 minutes of the conclusion of the event is required and a written one within 15 minutes.

Medal presentations will be conducted as soon as convenient following events. Medals will also be presented for Champion Life Saver, First Aid, Champion Patrol and those R&R events previously completed, at approximately 10.30 am on Sunday.

Code of Conduct – all people are expected to adhere to the SLSSA Codes of Conduct. Under no circumstances will abuse towards officials be tolerated and will be dealt with by the disciplinary committee.
