NOMINATION FEES:

Please note: Nomination fees will apply for State Championship Event Entries. No entry fees need accompany the nomination form, as these will be accounted for after the close of entries for the main SLSSA State Championships in 2010-11.



Patrol Hours:

The patrol hour qualification for entry into the 2010-11 State Board Riding Championships is by the existing ruling. Members have until the 31st December 2010 to complete appropriate hours as per SLSA Policy 5.4. Members not completing the current hours will forfeit medals, points and render themselves unable to compete in other State Championship events in season 2010-11.

All competitors must be proficient and financial for season 2009-10 and be the holder of the appropriate award at close of entries for the specific events entered.

ENTRIES

All entries are to be electronically entered into SLSSA **Events Management System**. A separate email has been sent to all Club Captains and Competition Officers with details of how to use this system.

MARSHALLING

All events will **ONLY** be marshalled when the Referee determines that the contest is about to proceed. Should an event be cancelled or rescheduled once it has started, only those marshalled competitors will be permitted to continue when the event restarts.



(This means that any competitor legitimately entered and who was unable to attend at a previously cancelled event **will be** permitted to compete, unless that event had been previously marshalled).

CHAMPIONSHIP JUDGING

The Board Riding State Championships may be judged by members of Surfing SA Judging Panel or SLSSA Officials.

In the event of poor board riding conditions, a backup date will be determined by the event referee in conjunction and cooperation of the Head Judge of Surfing SA

MEDAL PRESENTATIONS

As competitor patrol hours are being accrued until 31st December 2010, medals will be presented at the 2010-11 Senior State Championships.

COMPETITION CONDITIONS

Events will be conducted in accordance with the Surf Sports Manual – 33rd Edition (September 2008), and associated Bulletins issued by Surf Life Saving Australia from time to time. Further information of the Rules may be obtained from the SLSA website:
