ENTRIES

All entries are to be electronically entered into SLSSA **Events Management System**. A separate email has been sent to all Club Captains and Competition Officers with details of how to use this system.

NOMINATION FEES:

As this event is not formally part of the State Championship events, **please note that a nomination fee of \$5.00 per competitor (\$15.00 late entry)** will apply for the Board and Ski events. These will be accounted for through the clubs after the close of entries and therefore no fees need accompany nominations.

All competitors must be proficient and financial and be the holder of the appropriate award at close of entries.



EVENTS TO BE CONDUCTED: All Relay events (3 per team)

- Under 15 Board Relay (NGS)
- Open Board Relay (NGS)
- Open Ski (NGS)

Board and Ski Relays – if enough teams there will be 3 graded races A, B, C etc over 1000 m, 500 m and 250m, reasonable run legs. There will be approximately 10 min break in between races – alternate Open Ski / U 15 Board / Open Board so that paddlers wishing to do all races can do so.

MARSHALLING

All events will **ONLY** be marshalled when the Referee determines that the event is about to proceed. Should an event be cancelled or rescheduled once it has started, only those marshalled competitors will be permitted to continue when the event restarts.

(This means that any competitor legitimately entered and who was unable to attend at a previously cancelled event **will be** permitted to compete, unless that event had been previously marshalled).

In the event of poor conditions, a backup venue will be determined by the event referee

COMPETITION CONDITIONS

Events will be conducted in accordance with the Surf Sports Manual – 33rd Revised Edition, and associated Bulletins issued by Surf Life Saving Australia from time to time. Further information of the Rules may be obtained from the SLSA website:
