Subject: Carnival IRB Requirements

Please be advised that the roster below has been discussed and agreed upon by the SA IRB Panel. The roster will be the minimum requirement for the conduct of South Australian Carnivals on the Surf Sports Calendar of events 2010/11.

Clubs are required to provide a fully equipped, operational IRB with competent crew (1 x driver and 1 x crew) able to handle the conditions on the day. Crews may be interchanged during the day, however this is the responsibility of the club. Please note that host clubs will also be required to have a back up IRB in case of breakdown.

IRB crews will be required to report to the Carnival Safety Officer (Mr Bob Menhennett) no later than 7.00 am for allocation to their area. Crews will be required to lay their respective area cans, provide appropriate water cover throughout the entire carnival program and retrieve cans at the conclusion of the day.

If crews are using a state allocated IRB and motor, both boat and motor will be required to be washed down at the completion of use. If there is no water available at the site, this will be carried out at SLSSA Boat Shed, Lonsdale on return that afternoon. All damage no matter how minor will be reported to the Carnival Safety Officer or SLSSA Surf Sports Manager on the day or by 10.00 am on the following Monday of the carnival (SLSSA 83546900). Failure to meet this obligation will result in repairs being charged to the last rostered club.

A carnival Patrol Log is available for recording hours and is located in the carnival caravan. This patrol log will be completed on the day and duly signed at the completion of the carnival event activities; all hours will be logged by SLSSA into SurfGuard.

Host clubs will provide sufficient drinks/food throughout the carnival for all crew members of IRB's.

I understand that each year changes are required and swaps made between clubs. Please notify me on the numbers below if this is the case or if you would like to discuss any modifications.
