SUBJECT: Information regarding Junior Carnival 1 – Somerton 21st November 2010

Please note the following information regarding Junior Carnival 1 – Somerton 21st November 2010:

Please find attached a map showing the details for the Somerton Carnival. I understand that the layout is as it was at 2010 State Championships. The map also indicates car parking and trailer parking information. Somerton have again negotiated the use of Minda oval for cars to park on the grassed reserve. The entry point is shown on the map.

Catering will be available from the club.

Also a reminder to all clubs that it is imperative that official's quotas (Bulletin B10005) are met and appropriate water cover (Circular C10055) is provided, preferably with capacity to allow for breaks. Due to the introduction of the new Carnival Program for Junior Carnivals and the requirement for an extra water area, there is obviously also a requirement to increase the number of water cover personnel. As outlined in the Junior Activity Handbook, each Club is to supply qualified (proficient Bronze Medallion or Surf Rescue Certificate) water safety person/s with a SLSA approved rescue tube or board for the duration of the carnival.

To adequately meet requirements the following will be implemented for Junior Carnivals in season 2010-11. This will be reviewed following the first two Carnivals.

Number of competitors	Number of water cover personnel club to supply.
5 - 45	1
45 - 90	2
90 +	3



Club Media Personnel (Circular C10050) must have submitted a form for approval. Media bibs (from those clubs that have returned them) will be available from the Marshalling tent. A person from each club that has been nominated can collect and sign for your club bib.

A reminder that for insurance and safety purposes **all Clubs must provide a Carnival Entries Master Lists**. For those who will compete in water events this list must also record that they have successfully completed the competition skills evaluation (ocean timed swim). These must be submitted prior to or at the commencement of every Carnival.

Clubs are also requested to complete the event summary form by indicating approximately how many competitors will participate in each event and how many teams will be competing in each team event.
