**SUBJECT:** Information regarding upcoming surf sports events and Carnivals

At the Board of Surf Sports meeting conducted Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> January the following were agreed:

- South Port will host the R&R State Championships on Saturday February 12<sup>th</sup>.
- Grange will host Champion Lifesaver State Championships on February 3<sup>rd</sup> (theory) and 5<sup>th</sup> (practical). Please see Circular C10069.
- Semaphore will host Champion Patrol State Championships on February 3<sup>rd</sup> (theory – NOTE this will be at **Grange** as it will be combined with Champion Lifesaver), February 17<sup>th</sup> (Resuscitation if numbers require) and February 19<sup>th</sup> (practical). Please see Circular C10070.
- We are still seeking a host for First Aid State Championships.
- As the December 12<sup>th</sup> Carnival was cancelled, a Carnival will be conducted on February 13<sup>th</sup> at South Port. More details to follow but priority will be given to events not yet conducted (e.g. Tube races, Board Rescue, belt races etc) as well as events for which end of season trophies will be awarded. A program will follow.
- The February 13<sup>th</sup> Carnival will give another opportunity for clubs to be part of this season's March Past Handicap series. It is not too late for Club's to get teams together to qualify as there is this South Port carnival, West Beach Qualifying and then States to accumulate points.
- Junior Carnival 3 will be at North Haven on January 30<sup>th</sup>. A new program will be distributed prior to the Carnival
- West Beach will be hosting a new concept being a Twilight Masters Team Event on Friday February 4<sup>th</sup>. More details to follow.
- Brighton will be hosting the Brighton Jetty Classic on Sunday February 6<sup>th</sup>.
- You will note that a Masters category has been added to Champion Lifesaver. If numbers are sufficient this will be split into 30 -39 and 40 plus.

Congratulations to the Development Team that has just returned from the Southern States Development Camp in Tasmania. Very positive reports from all concerned and we were successful in winning the Challenge for the second year in a row.

The State Team heads for Sydney this weekend to compete in the National Interstate Championships. Good luck to all concerned.
