**SUBJECT:** Information regarding Junior Carnival 3 – North Haven 30<sup>th</sup> January 2011

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A new program format has been developed following feedback from the first two junior carnivals. This is a slightly modified Format with 5 events and 1.15 hour rotations to allow for more finals to be conducted if required and for all groups to be able to find time for a break. There is also some flexibility with events that may take longer by leaving age groups in the same area for a couple of rotations so that they can manage the time needed. **Hot Weather**

Obviously the issue we are monitoring closely is the weather and relevant weather reports. We will follow the relevant policy which is the **Environmental Risk Management Policy and Guidelines Policy Number: P05.001** and it can be found at:

**At this stage the intention is to start the carnival as set, monitor the conditions and enforce the policy if required.**

A reminder to all clubs that it is imperative that official's quotas (Bulletin B10005) are met and appropriate water cover (Circular C10055 and C10062) is provided, preferably with capacity to allow for breaks. Due to the introduction of the new Carnival Program for Junior Carnivals and the requirement for an extra water area, there is obviously also a requirement to increase the number of water cover personnel. As outlined in the Junior Activity Handbook, each Club is to supply qualified (proficient Bronze Medallion or Surf Rescue Certificate) water safety person/s with a SLSA approved rescue tube or board for the duration of the carnival.

To adequately meet requirements the following will be implemented for Junior Carnivals.

Number of competitors	Number of water cover personnel club to supply.
5 - 45	1
45 - 90	2
90 +	3



**Club Media Personnel** (Circular C10050) must have submitted a form for approval. Media bibs (from those clubs that have returned them) will be available from the Marshalling tent. A person from each club that has been nominated can collect and sign for your club bib.

A reminder that for insurance and safety purposes **all Clubs must provide a Carnival Entries Master List**. For those who will compete in water events this list must also record that they have successfully completed the competition skills evaluation (ocean timed swim). These must be submitted prior to or at the commencement of every Carnival.

Clubs are also requested to complete the event summary form by indicating approximately how many competitors will participate in each event and how many teams will be competing in each team event.

- Referees briefing at 7.30 am
- Team Manager's briefing at 7.45 am
