SUBJECT: Information regarding Junior Carnival 4 – Normanville 20th February 2011

The new program format developed following feedback from the first two junior carnivals has been previously distributed (C10073) and will be followed. This is a slightly modified format with 5 events and 1.15 hour rotations to allow for more finals to be conducted if required and for all groups to be able to find time for a break. There is also some flexibility with events that may take longer by leaving age groups in the same area for a couple of rotations. This is attached with only **one minor modification**. Due to no R&R **March Past will start at 8.00 am and all other events promptly immediately following March Past.**

A reminder to all clubs that it is **imperative that official's quotas** (Bulletin B10005) are met and appropriate water cover (Circular C10055 and C10062) is provided. Due to the introduction of the new Carnival Program for Junior Carnivals and the requirement for an extra water area, there is obviously also a requirement to increase the number of water cover personnel. As outlined in the Junior Activity Handbook, each Club is to supply qualified (proficient Bronze Medallion or Surf Rescue Certificate) water safety person/s with a SLSA approved rescue tube or board for the duration of the carnival. To adequately meet requirements the following will be implemented for Junior Carnivals.

5 - 45	1
45 - 90	2
90 +	3

A REMINDER that all Club Media Personnel (Circular C10050) must have submitted a form for approval.

For insurance and safety purposes **all Clubs must provide a Carnival Entries Master List**. For those who will compete in water events this list must also record that they have successfully completed the competition skills evaluation (ocean timed swim). These must be submitted prior to or at the commencement of every Carnival. Clubs are also required to complete the event summary form with approximate number of competitors and teams.
