Subject: Qualification Carnivals - **update**

Please find below a map of the proposed beach layout (although this is for juniors the seniors will be similar).

Junior Qualifying:

A list of events is below. ALL EFFORT WILL BE MADE TO FOLLOW THE PROGRAM BUT THERE ARE MANY CIRCUMSTANCES AND VARIABLES THAT MAY REQUIRE A CHANGE ON THE DAY AND THIS WILL BE AT THE DISCRETION OF THE REFEREE.

Senior Qualifying:

Events to be conducted at the West Beach qualifying carnival on Sunday 6th March are:

- Board Rescue, Rescue Tube Rescue, Rescue Tube Race- These events will be conducted down to and including the final.
- Heats will also be conducted for Surf Belt Races (if numbers are sufficient) with semi finals and final conducted at the State Championships weekend.
- U/15 Flags – down to 16
- Under 15 Ironman and Ironwoman down to 16
- Under 15 Cameron to final

START TIME: 8.30 am (March Past at 7.30)

NOTE that NO other events will be conducted on Sunday 6th March

NOTE CHANGE for MARCH PAST:

March Past will be conducted at 8.00 am on SATURDAY 5th March for juniors and

Senior will now march at 7.30 am on SUNDAY

Scrutineering for Boards and Skis

This will be done at the following times and locations:

- Sunday March 6th (Senior Qualifying Carnival at West Beach) from 8.00 am
- Wednesday 9th March (at Lonsdale Shed) 6.30 pm – 9.00 pm
- Saturday 12th March (Masters States at Christies Beach) from 9.00 am

The weather forecast for the weekend looks good being fine and around 30 degrees. Tides are shown below.

Parking of Trailers

Unfortunately vehicles are not allowed onto the beach. To give close proximity to the competition area please park trailers in the council car park to the North of the Club House. A club member will assist with directing the parking of the trailers. Please park only trailers there and park your vehicle elsewhere.

Tents

Tents are to be set up at the base of the sand dunes in front of the beach arena.

Shade

We will be supplying a "flyer" (shade) at each competition area for competitors only

Entry to the Competition Arena

As the tents will be located in front of the sand dunes to the north of the club house we propose that competitors use the beach access ramp to the north of the Club House

Toilets

Toilets are located just to the North of the Club House. In addition Toilets are available in the club house but please enter from the upper room with thongs/ shoes as the top room is licensed. Additional council toilets are located further north of the sprint track

Food and Drinks

Available from the Clubhouse (Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner meals , coffees, drinks etc) and BBQ / drinks on the concrete slab to the north of the Club House

Bins

10 Council Wheely bins will be spread across the competition area. Please ensure you use these.

A REMINDER that all Club Media Personnel must have submitted a form for approval as per Circular C10050.

It is **imperative that official's quotas** (Bulletin B10005) are met and appropriate water cover (Circular C10055 and C10062) is provided. As outlined in the Junior Activity Handbook, each Club is to supply qualified (proficient Bronze Medallion or Surf Rescue Certificate) water safety person/s with a SLSA approved rescue tube or board for the duration of the carnival. To adequately meet requirements the following will be implemented for Junior Carnivals.

45 - 90	2
90 +	3

Juniors are also reminded that they must present for marshalling with **correct uniform** (broad brim hat, long sleeve t-shirt/rashy).

All events and activities including discipline and protests will be conducted in accordance with the Surf Sports Manual 33rd Revised Edition. Protests -\$100 required per protest up front, there will be no invoices. A reminder that a verbal protest within 5 minutes of the conclusion of the event is required and a written one within 15 minutes.
