SUBJECT: 2010-11 Junior State Championships information

Please note the following information regarding the conduct of the 2011 Junior State Championships:

Marshalling for all first events will be at 7.30 am for 8.00 am start.

There will be 3 water arenas, modified arena, 4 flag arenas and a sprint arena. A list of events can be found below and on the website www.surfrescue.com.au under the Surf Sports section.

It is **imperative that official's quotas** (Bulletin B10005) are met and appropriate water cover (Circular C10055 and C10062) is provided. As outlined in the Junior Activity Handbook, each Club is to supply qualified (proficient Bronze Medallion or Surf Rescue Certificate) water safety person/s with a SLSA approved rescue tube or board for the duration of the carnival. To adequately meet requirements the following will be implemented for Junior Carnivals.

Juniors are also reminded that they must present for marshalling with **correct uniform** (broad brim hat, long sleeve t-shirt/rashy). Board handlers must also have club caps on.

All events and activities including discipline and protests will be conducted in accordance with the Surf Sports Manual 33rd Revised Edition. Protests - \$100 required per protest up front, there will be no invoices. A reminder that a verbal protest within 5 minutes of the conclusion of the event is required and a written one within 15 minutes.

Only age group managers and team marshal in competition area. 3 per age group and these people must have identification bibs or shirts. No exception.

ALL Club Media Personnel must have submitted a form for approval as per Circular C10050 and be wearing the allocated bib.



Medal presentations will be conducted as soon as convenient following events. Medals will also be presented for Champion Life Saver, First Aid and those R&R events previously completed, immediately prior to March Past on Sunday. Junior Life Saver of the Year will be presented on Sunday during the lunch break.

Events:

- March Past - no demonstration teams will be permitted.
- Two (2) person R&R will be conducted before March Past on Sunday at approximately 12.00
- Under 14 iron person will be conducted after March Past on Sunday.
- The Westpac Coin hunt will be conducted at lunch time on Sunday. Each club is to nominate their youngest competitor to participate.
- All age beach relay will be last event on Sunday **time permitting**.

Code of Conduct – all people are expected to adhere to the SLSSA Codes of Conduct. Under no circumstances will abuse towards officials be tolerated and will be dealt with by the disciplinary committee.

Car parking: Car parking **will be available in the car park on Point Malcolm reserve** (on the day this will be managed by the local Rotary Club) to the south of the club building. Please do not park on the reserve area between the club building and the boat ramp as this area is currently being landscaped as part of the coastal pathway development, **and will be utilized for trailer parking.**

Parking is available on Military Rd and side streets in the vicinity of Point Malcolm Reserve. **There is a large coastal car park just north of Fort Glanville.** Please observe local parking restrictions as Council officers do police these areas.

Catering & Hospitality: We will have a number of stalls selling food and drinks throughout the 2 days of carnival activity. You may wish to sample one of our popular Yiros, or a bacon and egg sanga. We will have all of the usual fare on offer at carnivals and maybe one or two 'specials'.

We hope to have a downstairs bar offering refreshments in the shade of a Marquee for patrons to revive themselves. The clubroom bar facilities will be open from 3.00 pm both Saturday and Sunday. You may wish to come down for a meal on Friday evening. Our dining room is open for orders from 5:30 pm. If you would like to book a table, please contact **Aina Hay 0431 030 426.**

Trailers and Beach Access: We encourage clubs to bring their gear trailers down to Semaphore on the Friday afternoon (18/3/11) from 4.00 pm. This will assist in allowing efficient setting up of the carnival arena. **There will be no trailer parking on the beach – all trailers will be required to be parked on the north side of the clubrooms.**

Pedestrian access to the beach is from the boardwalk to the south of the club and from the beach ramp to the north of the club. No unauthorised vehicles on the beach. Also please remove all cars from trailer parking area.

Security: We will have security on hand Friday and Saturday nights after the close of events for the day. Therefore, you may wish to leave tents on the beach on Saturday evening **BUT make sure you reload your board trailer Saturday night.**

Toilets: In addition to the club's internal facilities toilets are located as follows;

- Portable toilets to the south of the club building
- Toilets within the male and female change rooms
- Public toilet located on the eastern side of the club building
- Upstairs in the clubrooms
