SUBJECT: SLSSA Pool State Championships

Nominations for 2011 Pool State Championships can now be entered into the State Event Management System. All clubs have previously been issued with a username and password along with instructions for entering nominations. The Championships will be conducted on **Sunday 5th June: 12 noon to 5.00 pm – State Aquatic Centre, 443 Morphett Road, Oaklands Park.**

Close of Entries: 5.00 pm, Friday 27th May 2011

Close of Late Entries: 12.00 noon, Tuesday 31st May 2011

Events to be conducted on the day are detailed below. Unfortunately due to time constraints, we are restricted in what we are able to conduct. Competitors will also only be able to compete in a maximum of **2 (two) team age groups** per event and events will not be held up to wait for competitors.

An Officials forum (see Circular C10098) will be conducted at Seaton Swim Centre (1 Wilford Avenue, Seaton) on Saturday 4th June 12.30 – 2.30 pm.

NOTE that this will be followed by the SERC (Simulated Emergency Response Competition) from 3.00 – 5.00 pm.

A nomination fee of \$20.00 per competitor (\$60.00 late entry) will apply for the Pool Championships. These will be accounted for through the clubs after the close of entries.

Eligibility and qualification for entry into the 2011 Pool Championships is by the existing ruling. As this is a State Championship event for the 2010-11 season, members had until the **31st December 2010** to complete 16 hours or comply with SLSA policy 5.4 and relevant bulletins/circulars. All other eligibility criteria also apply including SLSA financial membership and are the holder of the appropriate award as per Surf Sports Manual Revised 33rd edition.

The following information is for all competing clubs.

- Each competing club will be required to provide officials as well as timekeepers and / or equipment helpers. A quota has been set (see Circular C10098) and clubs will need to comply to be able to compete.
- An Officials forum (see Circular C10098) will be conducted at Seaton Swim Centre (1 Wilford Avenue, Seaton) on Saturday 4th June 12.30 – 2.30 pm.
- Clubs are to provide their own rescue tubes and fins for those that require them.
- We will be seeking a loan of Manikins from clubs that have them.
- Club caps (or swim caps) must be worn and all must be consistent in team events.
