SUBJECT: 2011 SA IRB State Championship Nominations

This circular provides information on the 2011 IRB State Championships to be conducted at Glenelg SLSC on Sunday, 3rd July 2011. This will be the first event of the 2011-12 State Championships season.

Events to be conducted over 2 rounds where 9 or fewer teams have nominated and heats/semi final/finals where 10 or more team have nominated.

3 Event Conditions

All events where 10 or more crews have entered will complete heat/semi finals. The top 8 crews from each event will then contest the final. Events where 9 or less crews have entered will be 2 rounds of racing with the highest point score being declared the winner.

Points will be awarded: 1st=9, 2nd=8, 3rd=7, 4th=6, 5th=5, 6th=4, 7th=3, 8th=2, 9th=1. Crews, who fail to complete the course or are disqualified, will receive zero points for that event. The Team with the highest points tally will be the winner.

Medals will be awarded to the clubs who finish 1st, 2nd & 3rd

4 Rules and Regulations

Clubs are reminded that to take part in IRB Competition there are a number of rules and regulations relating to equipment, training and competition rules that need to be taken into consideration including the BoSS resolution that clubs are required to have competed in two carnivals to be eligible to compete in State Championships. If you are unaware of any of these requirements, all relevant documents are listed on the SLSA website.

5 Entry Procedure

All entries will be required to be completed on the entry system at <http://www.irbracingsa.com> website not later than **Friday 24th June 2011**.

Entries must contain the "Registered Name of Competitor" (as entered on SurfGuard Database) as nicknames and abbreviated names on entries **will be** rejected on the grounds that a competitor is not registered.

Entry fees for this event are not necessary as they will be included with the 2011/12 Senior State Championship Entry Fees.



6 Scrutineering

Will be conducted at "The Boat Shed", Kitawah St, Lonsdale, between 6.30pm-10:00pm Monday, 27th June 2011.

All craft to be used in competition are required for scrutineering. Craft should be presented with all equipment for competition as per the current scrutineering sheet.

Each craft should be correctly inflated with the **floor board removed**.

All Log books/sheets are to be completed (motor, craft, driver, crew and patient) and presented at time of scrutineering to the Referee.

Craft not meeting scrutineering standards will be required to be resubmitted as directed by the scrutineers in conjunction with the Referee.

Presentation

All presentations will be conducted at the Glenelg SLSC as previously mentioned in the timetable.

Substitutions

Substitution of competitors will be in accordance with 2.18 on page 2-19 of the Surf Sports Manual – 33rd Edition Revised (August 2010).

Competition Conditions

Events will be conducted in accordance with the Surf Sports Manual – 33rd Edition Revised (August 2010), and associated Bulletins issued by Surf Life Saving Australia from time to time. Further information of the Rules may be obtained from the SLSA website:
