SUBJECT: SLSSA Pool State Championships – update

As per previous Circular (C10097) the SLSSA Pool State Championships will be conducted on June 5th 2011 at the SA Aquatic and Leisure Centre (443 Morphett Road, Oaklands Park) from 12.00 noon to 5.00 pm. Many thanks to all those people that have now offered to assist.

The following information is for all competing clubs.

- Each competing club will be required to provide officials as per Circular C10098. This can be negotiated with the Referee (Heather Thompson). Again many thanks to all those offering assistance.
- **The Officials forum will be conducted at Seaton Swim Centre (1 Wilford Avenue, Seaton) on Saturday 4th June 12.30 – 2.30 pm. NOTE that this will be followed by the SERC (Simulated Emergency Response Competition) from 3.00 – 5.00 pm.**
- Clubs are to provide their own fins for those that require them. Rescue tubes and Manikins will be supplied. All equipment must comply with the ILS specifications as specified in the ILS Sports Manual section 11.
- Competition equipment will be subject to random scrutineering checks during the event.
- Protests - \$100 required per protest up front, there will be no invoices. A reminder that a verbal protest is required within 5 minutes of the conclusion of the event and a written one within 15 minutes.
- Club caps (or swim caps) must be worn and all must be consistent in team events. All event handlers must also have club caps on.
- Teams can arrive from 11.15 but only limited warm up will be available as the pool needs to be set for competition.
- Parking is available free of charge in the multi-story car park immediately in front of the SA Aquatic and Leisure Centre.
- Entry is via the 'Event Entry' gate and seating will be in the first 4 rows of the main Southern Stand. There will be no charge for spectators.
- Kiosk facilities will be available within the SA Aquatic and Leisure Centre.



- Marshalling will be critical as we will need to confirm all entries on the Centre system accurately for timing and recording purposes. Marshalling will take place in the designated marshalling room 15 minutes prior to event start. It will close 5 minutes prior to each event and NO late entries will be allowed. PA announcements will be made to remind competitors of marshalling requirements.
- Warm up – limited warm up and cool down will be available in lanes 0 and 9 at the direction of the Referee.
- Eligibility and qualification for entry into the 2011 Pool Championships is by the existing ruling. As this is a State Championship event for the 2010-11 season, members had until the **31st December 2010** to complete 16 hours or comply with SLSA policy 5.4 and relevant bulletins/circulars. All other eligibility criteria also apply including SLSA financial membership and are the holder of the appropriate award as per Surf Sports Manual Revised 33rd edition.
- Competitors will also only be able to compete in a maximum of **2 (two) team age groups** per event and events will not be held up to wait for competitors. Individual event entry is under the same ruling as normal carnivals and State Championships event as per Surf Sports Manual Revised 33rd edition (generally own age group plus open if eligible).
- A brief description of events is on the SLSSA website (Surf Sports / Competition / Pool Events)
- Code of Conduct – all people are expected to adhere to the SLSSA Codes of Conduct. Under no circumstances will abuse towards officials be tolerated and will be dealt with by the disciplinary committee.
