SAPOL has just informed us that to protect the integrity our VOAN we need to modify our process just a little. So please take note of the very important change to the national criminal history record check (NCHRC).

## NPC Changes-Effective Immediately

Club Presidents must ***NOT*** sign any forms until such time as the 100 point Police check has been completed. So the process is now.....

- Complete the online form- rather than hardcopy form, and then attend a police station with the completed form and 100 Point ID.
- Once signed off please take it to your Club President for his/her authorisation and VOAN number. Then send the forms off.
- The online downloadable PD267 can be accessed on the SAPOL website at [www.police.sa.gov.au](http://www.police.sa.gov.au) or on the SLSSA website [www.surfrescue.com.au](http://www.surfrescue.com.au) under administration > forms.

**Club Presidents must ensure that they do the right thing as too many misdemeanours may result in us losing our VOAN status and therefore our status to receive free Police checks.**
