SUBJECT: 2011 'Be Active' SLSSA Youth Development Camp (U/15 – U/18)

Previous State Development Camps have been acknowledged as a success, and such programs continue to be supported by SLSSA and Clubs as viable and necessary to ensure the future of Surf Life Saving.

This season Surf Life Saving SA is again conducting a camp for members from age groups U15 – U18 (for season 2010/2011). The Camp provides the opportunity for young members to be exposed to the many elements of Surf Life Saving. Additionally the program will encompass team building, personal development and a strong emphasis on fun.

The camp will be conducted this year in the **Flinders Ranges**, based around Wilpena Pound in the second week of the July School Holidays from **Tuesday 19th to Friday 22nd July 2011** and transport details are as detailed below with two options for transport pick up and drop off (SLSSA or Moana) or members can meet and pick up from the Camp venue.

Clubs should encourage members they believe are potential future leaders within their Club to nominate. A limited number of participants will be allowed at each camp. Each Club is guaranteed a minimum of **one (1) member** for the camp but please feel free to nominate up to three (3) members. Should applications received exceed this number clubs will be requested to prioritise their members.

OVERVIEW

The Surf Life Saving SA Development Camps are designed to provide a range of skills to participants. Participants are to be current members in the U15 – U18 age groups (season 2010/2011) and hold one or more of the following SLSSA awards – Bronze Medallion, Senior First Aid Certificate or Surf Rescue Certificate. Participants will be exposed to a variety of sessions that are designed to challenge them personally and in a team concept.

Objectives include:

- Enrich participants involvement in Surf Life Saving - retain members by offering satisfying experiences which are mutually beneficial.
- Offer personal development opportunities - realise an individuals potential.
- Promoting teamwork and socialisation.

COSTS

Clubs are advised cost per member attending the camps are not finalised however will not exceed \$250 per member. These costs include all meals, use of equipment and facilities, accommodation, resources and other literature, transport to and from the camp and a camp pack (including a camp shirt).

Clubs will be invoiced the total costs for members attending from their club. **Clubs are encouraged to meet or subsidise these costs.**

CAMP SUPERVISION

All members of the camp management team are registered members of Surf Life Saving SA who have completed all elements of the SLSA member protection policy including a current police certificate.

FUTURE CORRESPONDENCE

Applicants will receive all future correspondence regarding the camps via email. Therefore it is imperative that all applications include an email address that is regularly checked. This information will include:

- Camp program and timetable
- Transport details
- What to bring
- Camp supervisors and contacts
