All events will be conducted in accordance with the Surf Sports Manual 33rd revised edition

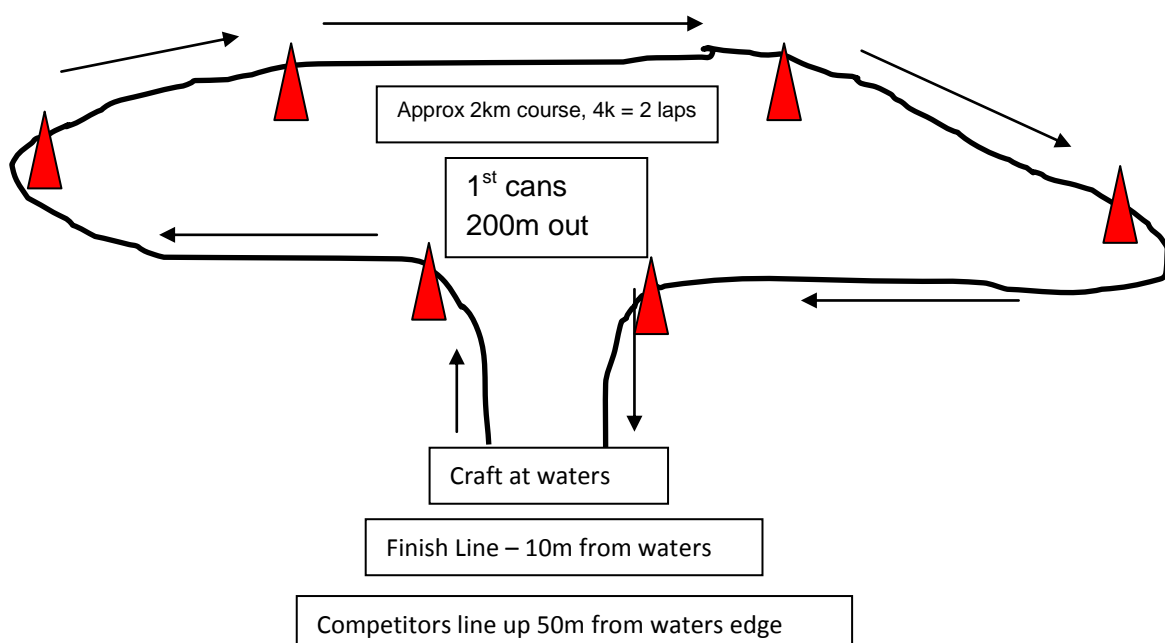
Race 1 – The Enforcer: Glenelg / Pat – (primarily flat water for event 1) Saturday 2nd October

Three races for all events. Approximate distances:

Ski: Race 1 - 4km (20min), Race 2 - 2km (10min), Race 3 - 1km (5min)

Board: Race 1 – 2km (20min), Race 2 – 1km (10min), Race 3 - 500m (5min)

- All paddlers to start together (pending numbers)
- 15 min break in between races – alternate Ski/U15/Board etc so that paddlers wishing to do all races can do so, albeit with minimal rest.
- Le Mans style start, 50m sprint to craft on waters edge



The winner in each category will be determined by the highest number of points accumulated over the 3 races (point score top 6 finishes: 7,5,4,3,2,1)

Under 15 Events- Board only (approximate distances)

Race 1 – 1km – (500m out and back again – around Glenelg Breakwater)

- This can be done during the Race 1 of the ski

Race 2 - 100m run – 500m board – 100m run

- This can be run during the Race 2 of the ski

Race 3 – straight 500m board race

- This can be run during the Race 3 of the ski

Draft Program (subject to change according to conditions):

12.45 pm - 1.15 pm: Marshalling, take names etc all competitors, events 1, 2 to be called to the line at 1.20 pm

1.30 pm: Event 1 Starts (Ski 4km)

1.35 pm: Event 2 Starts – Under 15 Board Race 1

1.45 pm: Marshall Event 3 (Board Race 1)

2.00 pm: Event 3 starts – Board Race 1 (2 km)

**those doing both ski and board will need to have someone marshall for them and have board on the line, faster paddlers will have about 10 mins rest.*

2.15 pm: Event 4 Marshalled – Ski Race 2

2.20 pm Event 5 Marshalled – Under 15 Board Race 2

2.30 pm Event 4 Starts – Ski Race 2 (2 km)

2.35 pm Event 5 starts – Under 15 Board Race 2

2.45 pm Event 6 Marshalled – Board Race 2

3.00 pm Event 6 starts Board Race 2 (1 km)

3.10 pm Event 7 Marshalled – Ski Race 3

3.15 pm Event 8 Marshalled – Under 15 Board Race 3

3.20 pm Event 7 starts – Ski Race 3 (1 km)

3.25 pm Event 8 starts – Under 15 Board Race 3

3.30 pm Event 9 Marshalled Board Race 3

3.40 pm Event 9 starts – Board Race 3 (500 m)

Main Rules:

- Course as per map but to be determined by Referee
- Start and finish as per map but to be determined by Referee
- All grades to start at once Le Mans style (pending numbers)
- Club Cap required

Race 2 – Relay Frenzy Saturday 16th October (small Surf Conditions – Goolwa / Moana) (to confirm on facebook and website pending conditions)

Board and Ski relays – 3 graded races A, B, C etc over 1000m, 500m and 250m, reasonable run legs.
Under 15 Board only.

Race 3 – Double Trouble Saturday 13th November (Small Surf Southport / Moana)

Ski: Double Ski Races – 3 Graded races A, B, C etc over a 1000m course out and back around apex cans as per SLSA guidelines.

- 10 - 14 teams in each grade/race (depends on availability of craft)
- Top 4 go up and bottom 4 go down each round

Board Races – 3 graded races over 1000m, 500m and 250m

- 16 in each grade/race (If conditions are good could have more in a race)
- Top 4 go up and bottom 4 go down each round

Under 15 Events- Board only

Race 4 - The Survivor Saturday 18th December (Surf Conditions – Goolwa / Moana) (to confirm on facebook and website)

Eliminator style racing.

- 3 x 500 m - 750 m sprint races 'M Course' – a percentage or set number of field drops off each race (depending on entries)
- Four minutes rest from 1st across line
- Race till the final four are reached
- Four minute break after each heat taken from the winner's finish time
- Board's will race first
- All races will be drag finishes

These will be accounted for through the clubs after the close of entries and therefore no fees need accompany nominations.

All competitors must be proficient and financial and be the holder of the appropriate award at close of entries.
