BOARD AND SKI EVENT 1: Sunday, 9th October 2011
Location: Grange Beach
Meeting Time: 9.00 am for ski and 10.00 for boards

BOARD AND SKI EVENT 2: Saturday, 15th October 2011
Location: Glenelg Beach
Meeting Time: 9.30 am for 10.00 am start

CLOSE OF NOMINATIONS:

Event 1: Wednesday 5th October 2011 at 5.00 pm
Event 2: Wednesday 12th October 2011 at 5.00 pm

CLOSE OF LATE NOMINATIONS:

Event 1: Sunday 9th October 2011 at 9.00 am
Event 2: Saturday 15th October 2011 at 9.30 am

ENTRIES:

All entries are to be electronically entered into SLSSA **Events Management System**. A separate email has been sent to all Club Captains and Competition Officers with details of how to use this system.

NOMINATION FEES:

As this event is not formally part of the State Championship events, **please note that a nomination fee of \$5.00 per competitor (\$15.00 late entry)** will apply for the Board and Ski events. These will be accounted for through the clubs after the close of entries and therefore no fees need accompany nominations. All competitors must be proficient and financial and be the holder of the appropriate award.

COMPETITION CONDITIONS:

Events will be conducted in accordance with the Surf Sports Manual – 33rd Revised Edition (August 2010), and associated Bulletins issued by Surf Life Saving Australia from time to time. Further information of the Rules may be obtained from the SLSSA website:

EVENTS TO BE CONDUCTED:

Should numbers be sufficient all age categories will be conducted e.g. Board only U/15 M&F. Board and Ski for U/17 M&F, U/19 M&F, Open M&F and Masters M&F)

Masters categories will be sorted according to the nominations received (e.g. 30-39 etc if nominations warrant it)

EVENT 1:

Ski: 3 person team pursuit 10 km for open and masters or 6 km for Under 17 and female (or any new paddlers that wish to do 6 km)

Board: 3 km team pursuit

Teams of 3 paddlers, 3rd paddler stops the clock. All teams can be NGS. Composite teams can be entered if approved by Referee.

EVENT 2:

The aim is to have three races with a break in between each. Approximate distances:

Ski: Race 1- 4 km, Race 2 – 2 km, Race 3 – 1 km

Board: Race 1 – 2 km, Race 2 – 1 km, Race 3 – 500 m

Under 15: Board only and shorter distances.

MARSHALLING:

All events will ONLY be marshalled when the Referee determines that the event is about to proceed.

Should an event be cancelled or rescheduled once it has started, only those marshalled competitors will be permitted to continue when the event restarts.

This means that any competitor legitimately entered and who was unable to attend at a previously cancelled event will be permitted to compete, unless that event had been previously marshalled.

In the event of poor conditions, a backup venue will be determined by the event referee to ensure the safety of all concerned.
