EVENT LOCATION:

The aim is to ensure the most suitable location for this event, so appropriate websites will be monitored and a decision made Wednesday night. People will be notified via website, email and Facebook on Thursday as to the chosen location. AS ABOVE CONFIRMED TO BE GOOLWA. **As per usual this is subject to the conditions on the day** and decisions will be made to ensure safety of all competitors.

ENTRIES:

Entries are to be electronically entered into SLSSA **Events Management System**.
Names only are required and teams can be sorted on the day.

NOMINATION FEES:

As this event is not formally part of the State Championship events, **please note that a nomination fee of \$5.00 per competitor (\$15.00 late entry)** will apply for the Board and Ski events. These will be accounted for through the clubs after the close of entries and therefore no fees need accompany nominations. All competitors must be proficient and financial and be the holder of the appropriate award.

COMPETITION CONDITIONS:

EVENTS TO BE CONDUCTED:

Board and Ski rounds will be conducted and relays if time permits. Composite teams and NGS teams will be permitted for clubs that do not have enough competitors to make teams.

MARSHALLING:

All events will ONLY be marshalled when the Referee determines that the event is about to proceed.

Should an event be cancelled or rescheduled once it has started, only those marshalled competitors will be permitted to continue when the event restarts.

This means that any competitor legitimately entered and who was unable to attend at a previously cancelled event **will be** permitted to compete, unless that event had been previously marshalled.

USE OF HIGH VISIBILITY LYCRA RACING VESTS FOR BOARD AND SKI SERIES EVENTS

As outlined in Bulletins B11008 and B11007, it was agreed that high visibility vest are to be used at senior events in South Australia this season especially when conducted in surf conditions.

More specifically, in regards to the Board and Ski Series events, this ruling means that it will be compulsory to wear a high visibility lycra racing vests to participate in these events.
