SUBJECT: 2011-12 Rescue & Resuscitation State Championships Instructions and Nomination form

Nominations are now sought from clubs for the 2011-12 Rescue & Resuscitation State Championships to be conducted at Port Elliot SLSC on Saturday 11th February 2012. Please note that Semaphore and Port Elliot will be working together to conduct these championships – many thanks to both clubs.

CLOSE OF NOMINATIONS: 12.00 noon, Friday, 3rd February 2012

CLOSE OF LATE NOMINATIONS: 12.00 noon, Tuesday 7th February 2012

EVENTS TO BE CONTESTED:

- U/10 – U/13 2 Person R & R (non-gender specific)
- U/12 – U/15 5 Person R & R (non-gender specific)
- U/15 5 Person R & R (non-gender specific)
- U/17 5 Person R & R (non-gender specific)
- U/19 5 Person R & R (non-gender specific)
- Open Mixed 5 Person R & R (refer Notes 1 & 2)
- Open Men's 5 Person R & R
- Open Women's 5 Person R & R
- Open 6 Person R & R (non-gender specific)

DATE OF EVENT: Saturday 11th February 2012
Port Elliot SLSC
Marshalling of Teams from 7.30 am
Competition commences at 8.00 am or as determined by Referee on the day (Brian Donnell)

Note 1: The gender combinations of male and female in the Open 5 Person Mixed R&R event must be mixed and may vary from 4-1 to 3-2 in either gender in each team. In addition, no "double dipping" is permitted in the Open 5 Person Mixed R&R and the Open 5 Man and/or Open 5 Woman R&R events at the same competition i.e. no competitor who has competed in the Open 5 Man R&R or the Open 5 Woman R&R event is permitted to enter and/or compete in the Open 5 Person Mixed R&R event at the same competition. Similarly, no competitor who has competed in the Open 5 Person Mixed R&R event is



permitted to enter and/or compete in the Open 5 Man R&R or the Open 5 Woman R&R event at the same competition. However, a competitor is permitted to compete in the U/15, U/17 and/or U/19 5 Person R&R events and/or the Open 6 Person R&R event and still be eligible to enter/compete in the Open 5 Person Mixed R&R event provided that they are a currently proficient Bronze Medallion holder.

Note 2: This event will be conducted under the rules as provided in the 33rd Edition of the Surf Sport Competition Manual and the Rescue and Resuscitation Competition Manual. Officials:

Clubs are advised that **EACH TEAM ENTERED** for these championships will be required to **PROVIDE 1 OFFICIAL** who will be required to judge events throughout the duration of the Championships. All officials are to report to Brian Donnell Referee not later than 7.30 am

Nomination Fees:

Please note: Nominations fees will apply for Junior State Championship Entries and Senior State Championship Event Entries. No entry fees need accompany the nomination form as these will be accounted for after the close of entries for the main SLSSA Senior and Junior State Championships for 2012.

Patrol Hours:

The patrol hour qualification for entry into the 2011-2012 Rescue and Resuscitation State Championships is by the existing ruling. Members had until the 31st December 2011 to complete 16 hours. Members not completing the hours will forfeit medals, points and render themselves unable to compete in other State Championship events in season 2011-12.

All competitors must be proficient and financial for season 2011-12 and be the holder of the appropriate award.
