Subject: 2011-12 Masters State Championships (Port Elliot SLSC) Instructions and Nominations

In regard to the 2012 Masters State Championships to be conducted at Port Elliot, clubs will be required to submit nominations (plus number of crews for Surf Boat Racing) on the form below. All remaining Masters Events will be open to all competitors on the day as long as they are on the Club Master list.

PLEASE NOTE – the Club **Master List of Competitors** is to be submitted (via on-line Event Management System or attached) to enable SLSSA staff to carry out administrative checks prior to the Championships. This process will ease the administrative burden on clubs and provide competitors the opportunity to enter as many or as few events that they wish.

A verification check will be carried out to ensure that the person lodging a nomination is (a) registered (b) proficient and (c) meets their patrol hour obligation.

At the 2010 Australian Championships the Masters timetable was modified at the request of the Masters Panel. In support of the request of the majority of masters competitors it was agreed to run the individual events the day before the team events. The SA Surf Sports Standing Committee (formerly Board of Surf Sports) has taken a position to mirror what is happening at the national surf sports level, **so please note:**

All individual events will be held on Saturday 25th February
All team events (including surf boats and beach events) will be held on Sunday 26th February

Officials on the beach will be provided with a Master List of Competitors to confirm the age category of each competitor.

Club Master List of Competitors Close:	5.00 pm	Friday, 17 th February
Club Surf Boat Nominations Close:	5.00 pm	Friday, 17 th February
Late Entries for all events Close:	12.00 noon	Tuesday, 21 st February

Competitors who wish to enter on the day will be required to lodge a nomination with the carnival administration along with a fee of \$90.00. Participation is not automatically assured because it will be subject to a check of registration, proficiency and patrol hours. If these cannot be verified on Surfguard then the competitor **WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO START.**

Surf Boat Nomination numbers will be received for both male and females in the following grades:

Nomination Fees:

Please note: Nomination fees will apply for Masters State Championship Entries. This has remained at \$30.00 per competitor (\$90.00 late entry).

No entry fees need accompany the nomination form as these will be accounted for after the close of entries.

Patrol Hours:

Patrol hour qualification for entry into the 2011-12 Masters State Championships is by the existing ruling. Members had until the 31st December 2011 to complete 16 hours or comply with SLSA bulletins/circulars. Members not completing the current hours will forfeit medals, points and render themselves unable to compete in other State Championship Events in season 2011-12.

All competitors must be proficient and financial and be the holder of the appropriate award at close of entries.
