SUBJECT: Information regarding Masters State Championships – Port Elliot 25th and 26th February

Many thanks to the Port Elliot club for their commitment to conducting this carnival. Please find below information relating to general conduct of the carnival.

Trailers to be parked at small car park to the east of the bowling club as per map below. Boats will access beach from boat ramp as shown on map. Port Elliot will have vehicle to assist getting onto beach if required as the ramp is narrow. All vehicles to be taken off the beach.

Catering will be available **from the Club** all day including B-B-Q, kiosk lines (soft drinks and rolls etc). A Cafe style coffee van will be available all day. Bar facilities open from 11.00 am each day.

Competitors must marshal at arrival and have age group marked on arm. We would encourage the Team Managers or 1 person from each club to marshal for each event rather than all competitors as they could be competing in another event.

A reminder that all 'handlers' require club caps and competitors are to marshal with cap on.

Security will be provided by **Great Southern Security Services** on the Saturday night only in the area designated for trailers.

Protests

All protests shall be lodged with the appropriate carnival official in accordance with the procedures set down in the current edition of the SLSA Surf Sports Manual and shall identify the specific sections/clauses in the Surf Sports Manual and or event rules upon which the protest is based. Protest Forms are available from the marshalling tent. An appeals fee of \$110.00 must accompany all protest appeals when submitted to the Appeals Committee for Adjudication

Code of Conduct

SLSSA expects that all members involved in competition will co-operate to ensure a positive public image and to participate in a spirit of goodwill and sportsmanship. The SLSA code of conduct is contained in the current edition of SLSA Surf Sports Manual and any subsequent Bulletins.

Any incidents or behaviour likely to cause embarrassment or damage to the reputation and/or image of lifesaving competition will be managed as prescribed in the current edition of SLSA's Rules, Surf Sports Manual and any subsequent Bulletins.
